Scholarship Applications: UAW Local 1112 Scholarship application forms are now available. There are ten (10) \$1,000 scholarships available this year: Seven (7) scholarships are funded by UAW Local 1112 – one (1) YSU, two (2) Kent State, two (2) University of Akron, one (1) at-large; and new this year one (1) Trade School.

Two (2) scholarships are funded by our retirees – one (1) YSU, and one (1) at-large.

This year, one of our YSU scholarships is funded by the John R. Facemyer family.

There are three different scholarship forms this year. One form is to be used for those attending YSU, Kent State, or University of Akron.

One form is to be used for attendance at a trade school. One form is for the “at-large” scholarship which is any other school not a trade school or area school (YSU, KSU, University of Akron). All applications **must be returned to the Education Committee at UAW Local 1112 by May 15, 2017.**
