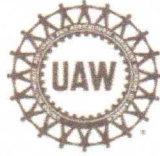

Greetings Brothers and Sisters;

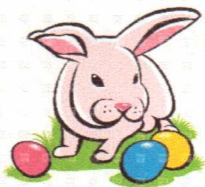

Martin Luther King Jr Holiday – January 15, 2018: As per the National Agreement, you must have worked the last scheduled work day prior to and the next scheduled work day after each specified holiday within the employee's scheduled work week. Use of VR days will not be permitted, unless excused in advance on the following days: Holiday qualifying days as specified in Paragraph (203) (3). The last scheduled work day in the week preceding a Monday holiday specified in P (203). The next scheduled work day in the week following a Friday holiday specified in P (203).

Acceptance of nominations for eleven (11) Election Committee Members (to serve a three (3) year term ending February 2021) will be held at this meeting. 


