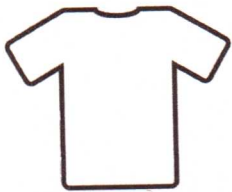

White shirts are worn to show Solidarity among workers and sends a message that blue-collar workers deserve the same respect as management. The Education Committee will be selling t-shirts in the East and West plants Welcome Centers and in the Paint Shop Cafeteria. Shirts are \$15 each. We will also have a 50/50 raffle. All proceeds will go toward the Scholarship Program.
