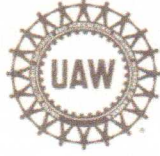


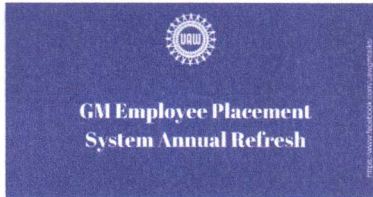

Reminder GM Employee Placement System Annual Refresh:** GM members who currently have an open Area Hire, Extended Area Hire or a Return to Former Community Application who wish to transfer to another plant must enter a new application in the Employee Placement System, no matter how recently you submitted your current application.

You will first have to cancel your current application, but you will be able to immediately resubmit your application. This will prevent the NEPC from deleting your application during the annual purge of the system and will ensure you will not miss the opportunity you're waiting for to transfer when it arises.

Winter Hazards Safety Tips: Every winter the hazards of driving in snow and icy conditions are noted, but rarely is walking on snow and ice addressed. Tips to remember this winter 1. Wear proper footwear with heavy treading and a flat bottom. 2. Wear things that help you see and be seen such as sunglasses and also bright and reflective clothing. 3. Walk consciously on icy sidewalks and parking lots. 4. Avoid listening to music or talking on the phone while walking in icy or snowy conditions. Pedestrians need to be able to hear approaching traffic. 5. What appears to be pavement may be black ice, so approach it with caution. 6. A shortcut path may be dangerous because it is less likely that snow and ice removal occurred. 7. When entering a building the floors may be covered in melted snow and ice, so

check the entrance and try to step on any rugs in the doorway. 8. When walking down steps, go slowly and deliberately. Plant your feet securely on each step and be sure to hold on to the handrail. **Most importantly leave yourselves some extra time. Slipping and falling while walking accounts for a large number of winter-related injuries and can have an impact on the quality of life for the injured person.**
