Our Credit Union offers a wide variety of services and can assist members in many ways. Please contact our local branch to inquire about any of your financial needs.

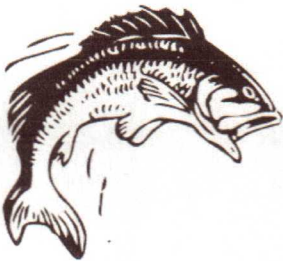
The UAW has had a long standing commitment to "Support those that support us" if we don't support our local branch we could lose the ability have a top ranked Credit Union in our own back yard.



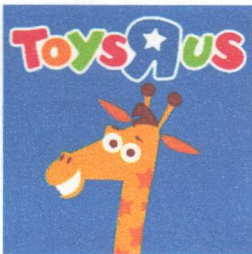
