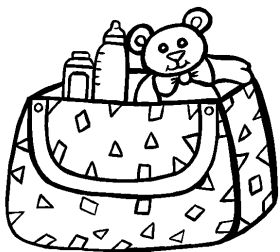
All Peoples Meeting: Management has informed your leadership that the all people meeting will be held soon. The details are still being worked out and we will inform you as soon as we have a confirmed date.
