RUN HIDE FIGHT: Unfortunately, the world which we live in seems to get more violent every day. When you go out anywhere by yourself or with your family members you should always think: What if there is an active shooter; how will I get out of here?

Don’t wait until something happens. Do this first. Most active shooter events last around ten to fifteen minutes and are very random. Your first response should always be to run out the nearest exit that’s away from the shooter. Do not waste time gathering your belongings. (Remember that all buildings are required to have back doors). Do not stop to help others. You need to get outside in a safe area first, then call 911. If you cannot run, then hide. Get to a room with a door and go inside, lock the door and turn off lights and your cell phone. If you cannot get to a room, hide anywhere that the shooter will not see you. Your last and final resort is to fight back. Use anything as a weapon to disable the shooter.

Hopefully, you or your family members will never be put in this situation, but remember, **RUN, HIDE, FIGHT!!**
