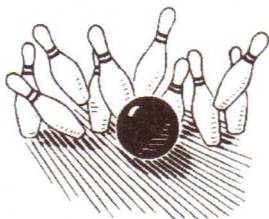


**Ladder Safety:** With the holiday season just around the corner, all of us will probably be using ladders of some kind to hang decorations. There are a couple of things to remember when choosing the right ladder. The environment of your work site is the first factor in choosing your ladder. The next factor is the length. It is unsafe to use a ladder that is too long or too short. Never stand above the second step from the top. The duty rating of the ladder is the next factor. This is the maximum weight the ladder can safely carry (your weight plus any tools and supplies). There are five categories of ladder duty ratings: Type 3 light duty 200lbs; type 2 medium 225lbs; type 1 heavy duty 250lbs; type 1A extra heavy duty 300lbs and type 1AA extra heavy duty 375lbs. You will find the duty rating sticker is on the side of the ladder. Always inspect your

ladder for defects before use. Make sure you always maintain three points of contact when going up and down the steps on ladder (two feet one hand or two hands one foot). Also hunters, remember to put on your safety harness before getting into your tree stands. A fall from any height could be a life-altering event.

**Support Union Workers:** Twenty (20) service and support operators who work with almost 700 citizens at the Portage County Developmental Disabilities Unit B have been on strike since October 4th. They haven't had a raise for 10 years and the County Board of Directors has hired scabs and private security firms to harass the striking workers. Many of the workers live in Mahoning and Trumbull counties. The Board, which is appointed by the Portage County commissioners and Probate Court has refused to bargain in good faith to resolve the strike. The workers want an agreement, so they can return to helping those in need. The picket line is located at 2606 Brady

Lake Rd. in Ravenna and is manned from 7:30 am-4 pm Monday-Friday. If you're interested in supporting the workers, especially if you live over that way, they would appreciate some people to walk the picket line, water, food etc.



**Don't Get Scammed:** There is an email going around claiming to be from Chase. They need you to verify your account and give you instructions to follow to do so. If you don't you will be you will be dropped from their data base. This is not from Chase and is a phishing scam. If a member did fall for this, they need to get to their Chase bank and have their account numbers changed. If they have a Chase credit card they will need to call the number on the back of the card and get a new account number and card.
